

NMF PRIMARY CARE LEADERSHIP PROGRAM PCLCP

About the Program

Faced with an increasing shortage of primary healthcare professionals in the United States, the **NMF Primary Care Leadership Program (PCLCP)** develops future leaders in the field, improving access for the nation's most underserved communities. For **six weeks** each summer, PCLCP Scholars experience the challenges and rewards of primary care in community health centers (CHCs) across the nation through **leadership training, service-learning projects, and healthcare delivery.**



Eligibility & Awards

PCLCP candidates are students from underrepresented minority groups and/or socioeconomically disadvantaged backgrounds. Applicants must be enrolled in one of the following accredited training programs, in the United States:

- **Medicine** (Typically, 1st and 2nd year students)
- **Nursing** (Master's and Doctoral students)
- **Physician Assistant** (Master's and Doctoral students)

Throughout the program, Scholars conduct a project to help build capacity at their CHC site. PCLCP Scholars will each receive a **\$5,000 scholarship stipend**, which is expected to cover travel, living, and lodging expenses during the program.
