

2020 Drs. Ludlow & Ruth Creary Family Foundation Scholarship

About the Scholarship

Established in 2020, this Scholarship will provide **\$2,500 to an African American or Black 2nd-year undergraduate student from California** interested in the Allied Health Professions.

Eligibility

Eligible applicants to the Drs. Ludlow & Ruth Creary Family Foundation Scholarship must:

- Identify as African American or Black
- Have primary residence in California
- Be enrolled as a second-year (i.e. Sophomore) at an accredited US four-year college or university for the 2019-2020 academic year
- Have demonstrated interest in the allied health professions

How to Apply

- **Please label email subject as "2020 Drs. Creary Scholarship"**

Application Components

- One Personal Statement demonstrating interest in pursuing a career in the allied health professions, citing specific examples and any individuals who have influenced the student's interest (750 Words Max)
- One Letter of Recommendation
 - Recommender must be able to comment on the student's achievements and interest in the allied health professions
 - **Recommender must email letter to Scholarships@nmfonline.org and label email subject "[Student Name - 2020 Drs. Creary Scholarship]"**
- Proof of US Citizenship or Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) approval letter (valid during the application timeline)
- Brief biosketch (250 Words Max)
- Current undergraduate academic transcript
- Resume
- Letter of financial aid from current academic institution (if any)



Application Timeline

- Application opens Monday, March 16 2020
- Application closes Monday, May 4, 2020, 11:59pm PST
- Scholar selected and notified June 2020
- If Selected Scholar is in proximity to Los Angeles, he/she will be required to attend NMF Los Angeles Champions of Health Awards June 18, 2020
- Scholarship funds disbursed upon submission of acceptance documents
